BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO ESTABLISH A
ZEBRA CROSSING ON QUEENS DRIVE, BEDFORD.

Reason for Proposal: This proposal is aimed at improving pedestrian safety on Queens Drive, Bedford outside 18 Queens Drive. A zebra crossing will provide an identified, controlled crossing point for pedestrians.

The Location of the Proposed Zebra Crossing is on Queens Drive, Bedford, outside 18 Queens Drive. The centre of the crossing will be 8m west of the edge of the Arrow Leys junction.

Further Details of the proposed zebra crossing, a plan and a statement of reasons for proposing to establish the crossing may be examined during normal working hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford. These documents are also available on the www.bedford.gov.uk website. The details will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the crossing is commissioned or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
